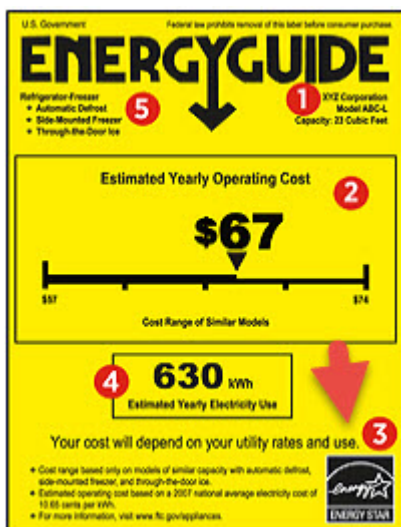
Residential or Commercial

Member Requirements:

- Member must own an EV or own business that allows charging
- Install a level 2 charger
- Complete rebate application
- Provide a copy of invoice with make & model
- Provide Energy Guide with Energy Star logo, or equivalent documentation
- Save document before submitting

Information:

- Any Level 2 or 3 EV charger qualifies
- Rebate is a one-time credit of \$250 for energy star rated chargers unless check marked
- Rebate is a one-time credit of \$125 for non-energy star rated chargers unless check marked
- Rebate is a one-time credit for \$2,000 for level 3 commercial chargers unless check marked
- Rebate is applied to members account on the first of the month once completed packet is received and approved
- Buy local is \$25 if rebate qualifies
- Energystar.gov is a resource if member does not have energy guide
